I. {1a, 4d}

Restoring the Ministry of Trust...God, Family, Yourself...Without Judging

Presented by Rev. Curtis Bennett

Ref. Hebrews 12:25-28; Gal. 6:7-9

- a. God promise to shake heaven and earth. Everything that is not of God will fall away, but the kingdom of God cannot be moved.
- b. When believers lose trust in God it affects the entire family of Christians. Sadly, those around Christians will cast their thoughts of good and evil. The ministry is affected therefore causing ripples of pain, frustration, and a lack of confidence.
- c. Entitlements has become well entrenched into the fabrics of America's culture that if entitlements are done away with it would be detrimental to millions of American. If entitlements are cut off, to include Social Security, Medicare, and Medicaid, how would you respond to these situations? Are you totally depended on governance for your needs? Trust in the Lord!
- d. We live in the age of attitude among many who rejects godliness and the word of God. How can you make a difference in an ungodly society? How will you manifest yourself?

Manifested Thought:

Small things can suddenly equate to great dilemmas. (See Genesis 3:1-9.) In the case of Adam and Eve they stayed quiet and tried to hide from God. The serpent made a statement "you shall not surly died". New age theology expounded on by well-known people have said "there are many ways to heaven".

To counter such a statement, would this be judging the person who said it?

Could this be considered an opinion by speaking against this teaching?

If the name of the person who said it was mentioned, would this draw your attention toward the person who said it rather than what was said?

The statement has nothing to do with the person who said it but rather the words that was spoken must be refuted and rebuked.

Moses broke the tablets of stone at the bottom of the mountain because he saw what had happen when he was away from the people 40 days. However, the words written on the stone could not be done away with. As touching the Church, Jesus is that stone that was rejected and put back together by God that will never be replaced or broken.

II. {1b, 5b}

Serving Gratefully

Presented by Rev. Floyd Dugger

Ref. John 11:41-42; I Cor. 15:35-38; Hebrews 13:18-20; Hebrews 12:28

- a. It is through the blood of the everlasting covenant of Jesus Christ that every good work is perfected to do God's will.
- b. Fascination has gripped the brightest minds concerning the universe such as global warming, climate change, greenhouse gas emissions, carbon print, artificial intelligence taking over human existence, etc. Seeing that these things supposed to affect the entire world, should Christian be as fascinated and concern as the world, regarding human existence and extending life in the earth?
- c. How will you manifest yourself above all of these things?

Manifested thought:

God made mankind for a reason. No one today was a mistake or an accident. And because God made us, only He can tell us what we were made to be. Our purpose in life revolves around Him. Therefore, the only way for us to find lasting joy and satisfaction is to devote ourselves to fulfilling His purpose for our lives. Contrary to God's purpose, sin is a conduit for death. Nonetheless, Jesus is the "Minister of the Sanctuary" the captain of our salvation.

III. {1c}

Cultural Problems – Affecting the Family

Presented by Rev. Phillip Appling

Ref. Hebrews 3:8-14; Romans 1:24-32; Matthew 24:32-38

A great deal of the New Testament is devoted to exhorting and warning Godly believers, on the subject of entering into the kingdom of heaven. But today, many Pastors and leaders of the church body have ceased warning the people. What do you believe is the reason for not warning the people of God?

Manifested Thought:

- Problems arise when the expressed word of God is neglected and rejected!
- Hidden sins, same sex marriage, adultery, and works of the flesh continues to be manifested among believers.
- Leaders and church members have been known to have had adulterous affairs within their congregations. How is this a problem when it happens?
- What happens when many are aware of the sinful situation but no one addresses the issues?
- Should churches call to a vote whether to install a gay cleric to a pastor's position? God is love and He wants us to be at peace, after all we are made in God's image. Is this the right approach to deal with this issue of installing gay clerics?
- How will you manifest yourself?

IV.

{2a, 5a}

Walking, Strengthen, Giving [Walking (to die daily), Strengthen (by the Spirit), Giving (for God's glory)]

Presented by Minister Tonya Jones

Ref. Colossians 1:23-29; Hebrews 12:22-25; I Cor. 15:31, 9:27; 2 Cor. 13:5; Proverbs 18:21

- a. Jesus is the head of the Church, wherein the body of believers are institutionalized into Christ to form a complete assembly before God.
- b. This is a foundation that is established for the purpose of promoting the kingdom of God.

Manifested Thought:

Jesus does not expect people to fall in love with features and buildings, nor does He expect believers to follow pastors and denominations that give way to failure. Jesus says follow me and I will make you fishers of men. And in another scripture He says "Come unto me, all *ye* that labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls" Matthew 11:28-29). It is pertinent for every Christian to know the cause of ministry!

Am I challenging and exercising my ministry the way God intended for me too, when I know many Christian around me and in my Church are afflicted and many appear to have little or no spiritual growth? What does it mean to die daily? What is implied "by the Spirit"? How do I know what is for God's glory? How do I manifest myself in these situations?

V.

{3a, 4a}

Cultural Shifts: Religion & Politics

Presented by Minister Maurice Jackson

Ref. Matthew 12:36; I Cor. 4:1-5; Luke 16:2; John 16:32-33

- a. Religion and politics will never go away. Are you sold out for Jesus? A battle of good and evil persist in both elements. Both elements are undergoing cultural shifts.
- b. The philosophy of "political correctness" has proven to be acceptable over realities of life.
- c. What is the most important thing for the Church to do in this modern day? (To be an overcomer but what does that look like?)
- d. What is manifested in the scriptures that give accountability and how will you manifest yourself for accountability?

Manifested Thought:

"No truth is more evident to my mind than that the Christian religion must be the basis of any government intended to secure the rights and privileges of a free people... When I speak of the Christian religion as the basis of government... I mean the primitive Christianity in its simplicity as taught by Christ and His apostles, consisting of a belief in the being, perfections, and government of God; in the revelation of His will to men, as their supreme rule of action; in man's... accountability to God for his conduct in this life; and in the indispensable obligation of all men to yield entire obedience to God's commands in the moral law and the Gospel."

VI. {3c, 4c}

Moral Principles & Precepts (Religious Conscience)

Presented by Minister Wanda Jones

(The Spirit of God for a Spiritual Relationship)

Ref. John 8:9; 2 Cor. 1:12; I Peter 2:19; I Peter 3:16

- a. Religious conscience and moral principles is manifested in the Church which leads to life and death.
- b. Conceivably the greatest way in which man resembled his Maker was in his moral nature resulting in moral principles to acknowledge God. Man was created sinless, giving dominion, and was clothed with the righteousness of God. It was because of this fact he was able to have fellowship with God. It was this that he lost in the fall and caused him to realize that he was naked.
- c. Science is a critical aspect of human existence, but it cannot address the spiritual nature of man.
- d. How will you manifest yourself against the man of sin while staying true to God?

Manifested Thought:

There are three points of doctrine the belief of which forms the foundation of all morality. The first is the existence of God; the second is the immortality of the human soul; and the third is a future state of rewards and punishments. Suppose it possible for a man to disbelieve either of these three articles of faith and that man will have no conscience, he will have no other law than that of the tiger or the shark. The laws of man may bind him in chains or may put him to death, but they never can make him wise, virtuous, or happy. - John Quincy Adams

VII. {2b, 4b}

Marriage Institution (Ordained and instituted by God)

Presented by Rev. Stephen Crabtree

Ref. I Cor. 7:14

- a. Marriage was not included in the Great Commission but it is ordained of God to be pure and holy that men and women should come together and multiply. The whole family is to be as one as an institution with the same common goals, and (family, business, academics, etc.) interest, serving the Lord their God.
- b. And God blessed them, and God said unto them, be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moves upon the earth” (Genesis 1:28).
- c. “And the LORD God caused a deep sleep to fall upon Adam, and he slept: and he took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh instead thereof; And the rib, which the LORD God had taken from man, made he a woman, and brought her unto the man. And Adam said, this *is* now bone of my bones, and flesh of my flesh: she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man” (Genesis 2:21-23). Indisputable truth will always be found in the word of God.

Manifested Thought:

Is it possible for marriage to be sanctioned or instituted by governance of mankind? One would certainly argue that mankind can endorse marriage as God instituted it from the beginning. On the other hand can mankind change the sovereignty of God and redefine marriage? Do you believe that it is alright with God if mankind make their own rules about marriage as they go from one generation to the next? What is manifested in the institution of marriage?

VIII. {2c, 5c}

The Divide of God & Man

Presented by Pastor Debra Hanna

Ref. James 3:13-18; Proverbs 2:6-22

- a. Rejection of God is the absent of wisdom which is to be lead about without a moral compass. Wisdom is the deliberator, *(to act with a particular intent...to influence the choice to be made)*, of the soul that feeds into knowledge, discretion, and understanding the path of life.
- b. The false principal of the “Separation of Church and State” has moved to a level that is clearly a rejection of God’s ways. There are daily articles that shows man’s rejection.
- c. The general view of truth has changed several times since the 16th century. Rationalism, empiricism and existentialism eventually gave way to post-modernism, which has since been concluded there was no such thing as truth, no such thing as meaning, and no such thing as certainty.

Manifested Thought:

Wisdom is described as principle for understanding and discretion. God’s wisdom laid the foundation of the world, framed the world and completed the universe, yet man insist that evolution is the cause and effects of the world. As atheism, equality principles and secular humanism continues to grow in America what will it mean and take to stay true to God?

Equality: man’s version of fairness and justice.

Is it time for Christian to manifest God’s ways or keep harmony and remain politically correct? Should Christian simply setback and go along for the ride when the word of God will hold Christian accountable for every work done in their bodies? Is it possible to be completely independent of God without gross consequences? What does it mean to have the Church completely separated from the state of men affairs? Will not the affairs of men negate the affairs of the church?

IX. {3b}

Lawlessness (Man ways vs. God’s ways)

Presented by Dr. Douglas Stewart; Assisted by Justine Gordon

Ref. Heb. 12:1-2; Rev 3:14-22; Isaiah 6:1-9; Romans 1:29-32; 2 Timothy; 3:1-5; Proverbs 19

- a. Lawlessness is knowing the ways of God but ignores God’s ways for selfish reasons. This is the spirit of the latter days. Wherefore we observe scriptures that declares the events of the latter days are lacking unto the days of Noah; eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage until the flood came. Matthew 24:37-38.
- b. Lawlessness is an advocate for luke warmness. (See Revelation 3:14-22.)
- c. Lawlessness: The reference of lawlessness does not engage men laws but it refute the ways of God and considers the individual’s laws within men to walk according to their own feelings, desires, persuasions, and social equalities, to be politically correct as to some form of social justice. It refutes righteousness and others forms of laws which brings in anarchical dictates. Furthermore, we recognize transgression against God is lawlessness.
- d. There also is another law Apostle Paul address by saying, “I find then a law, that, when I would do good, evil is present with me. For I delight in the law of God after the inward man: But I see another law in my members, warring against the law of my mind, and bringing me into captivity to the law of sin which is in my members” (Romans 7:21-23).

3b continues

Manifested Thought:

We live in busy times. For many Christians, church is an item on their checklist, and they think attending a service fulfills their spiritual duty. As a result, God seems distant, so they feel unexcited about His work in their lives and lack compassion for the unsaved. Such believers find it easy to start acting in a worldly manner. What must these Christians do to manifest their works before God in a good conscience?

What are the issues on a political, economic and spiritual scale? How does the Church address these issues of today? Lawlessness is a conduit of choice by the evil one to cause iniquity to abound and the love of many to wax cold. How does lawlessness wear down and wear out Christians? When Christians do not know what's going on in the world is it because they don't care or simply do not consider anything to be of a concern for the Church? This is the transgression of the Law.

X. {3d)

Beyond Worldly Ambition & Politics (Overcoming Seducing Spirits)

Presented by Rev. Philip Appling

Ref. Acts 20:29; I Tim. 4:1-10; Revelation 2:20

- a. Atheist lead an invocation in a city hall council meeting in Florida nonetheless, atheist do not pray to the living God, so what should the council members look forward too?
- b. There was a Satanic Christmas tree raised in the state capital of Florida. The tree was raised in honor of the devil to mock Christians. The image Nebuchadnezzar was raised in demand of worship by all? "Woe unto them! For they have gone in the way of Cain and ran greedily after the error of Balaam for reward, and perished in the gainsaying of Core" (Jude 1:11). Is there any difference between the two images?
- c. It is obvious what the devil is manifesting but what should Christian do in these situations mentioned? (a, b)

Manifested Thought:

As the end times are coming closer, sin is being exposed like never before, and God is giving His people Divine wisdom to deal with the exposures. Yet some Christians ask, how should I behave around people in my family, my work place, my church etc., who are consumed by seducing spirits? I have tried to stand strong and pray but my energy is zapped, and I'm about to give up. Will I ever win over this spirit?" This session will provide information for spiritual healing and restoration in building the body of Christ, through the truth and obedience of His word.
