physical bodies (flesh) as well as in their spirits, since
both belong to GOD (I Cor. 6:20)

Understanding the resurrection of God by the Holy Spirit

“If the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, he who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit who dwells in you”
(Romans 8:11 (ESV)).

(Rom. 8:10) The body is dead: It is still mortal and subject not only to death but also to the temptation of sin. The Spirit is life anticipates v.11 and the hope of resurrection.

- a. Eternal life for humanity has long been the plan of God and the desire of mankind. From the time of creation when God breathed into Adam and he became a living soul, mankind was endowed with an eternal soul.
- b. When sin entered it brought death both physical and spiritual. Then Jesus Came. Those who receives Him finds eternal life through the indwelling of the Holy Spirit.
