

Blaspheme Blaspheming The Holy Spirit

- Matthew 12:31 WHEREFORE I SAY UNTO YOU, ALL MANNER OF SIN AND BLASPHEMY SHALL BE FORGIVEN UNTO MEN: BUT THE BLASPHEMY AGAINST THE HOLY GHOST SHALL NOT BE FORGIVEN UNTO MEN.
- v.32. AND WHOSOEVER SPEAKETH A WORD AGAINST THE SON OF MAN, IT SHALL BE FORGIVEN HIM: BUT WHOSOEVER SPEAKETH AGAINST THE HOLY GHOST, IT SHALL NOT BE FORGIVEN HIM, NEITHER IN THIS WORLD, NEITHER IN THE WORLD TO COME.
- This is the unpardonable sin. It is committed by word of mouth, but we should read on to verse 34, for here Christ makes clear that out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaketh (Matthew 12:34).

“For the gate is narrow and the way is hard that leads to life, and those who find it are few” **Matthew 7:14 (ESV)**

I John 5:16 IF ANY MAN SEE HIS BROTHER SIN A SIN WHICH IS NOT TO DEATH, HE SHALL ASK, AND HE SHALL GIVE HIM LIFE FOR THEM THAT SIN NOT UNTO DEATH: **THERE IS A SIN UNTO DEATH: I DO NOT SAY THAT HE SHALL PRAY FOR IT.**
