Saved By Grace {Eph. 2:5-8}

- ◇ Even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ—by grace you have been saved—⁶ and raised us up with him and seated us with him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus,⁷ so that in the coming ages he might show the immeasurable riches of his grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus.⁸ For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God,

- ◇ ¹⁶ That is why it depends on faith, in order that the promise may rest on grace and be guaranteed to all his offspring—not only to the adherent of the law but also to the one who shares the faith of Abraham, who is the father of us all, **Romans 4:16 (ESV)**
- ◇ ¹⁵ But the free gift is not like the trespass. For if many died through one man's trespass, much more have the grace of God and the free gift by the grace of that one man Jesus Christ abounded for many. **Romans 5:15 (ESV)**
- ◇ If the dough offered as firstfruits is holy, so is the whole lump, and if the root is holy, so are the branches. ¹⁷ But if some of the branches were broken off, and you, although a wild olive shoot, were grafted in among the others and now share in the nourishing root of the olive tree, ¹⁸ do not be arrogant toward the branches. If you are, remember it is not you who support the root, but the root that supports you. **Romans 11:16-18 (ESV)**

Covenant of Grace

- ◇ Covenants are integrated and/or combined into each dispensation that exploits the dispensational objective. When the word covenant is used in this study it is the expression of the sanction and scariness of God's promises to His people; not just a mere contract that is easily broken without consequences. Covenants are established with promises between God and man; communities, individuals, offspring, Jew and Gentile.
- ◇ "And God spake unto Noah, and to his sons with him, saying, and I, behold, I establish my covenant with you, and with your seed after you; and with every living creature that *is* with you, of the fowl, of the cattle, and of every beast of the earth with you; from all that go out of the ark, to every beast of the earth. and I will establish my covenant with you; neither shall all flesh be cut off any more by the waters of a flood; neither shall there anymore be a flood to destroy the earth" (**Genesis 9:8-11**).
- ◇ In the case of Noah and His family, God established a covenant with them because of 1) grace 2) to preserve life 3) to rid the earth of the evil that had corrupted the entire earth. After the flood was over God established another covenant with Noah and all living creatures for his glory, honor, and salvation to come.

Covenant of Grace

- ◇ Covenants are established tokened (sign, signed) by the one who establishes it. Genesis 9:13. God's signature is established by a rainbow that he will honor His covenant between all His fleshly creatures He formed.
- ◇ "For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, declares the LORD: I will put my law within them, and I will write it on their hearts. And I will be their God, and they shall be my people. ³⁴ And no longer shall each one teach his neighbor and each his brother, saying, 'Know the LORD,' for they shall all know me, from the least of them to the greatest, declares the LORD. For I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more" **(Jeremiah 31:33-34 (ESV))**
- ◇ "Thus says the LORD, who gives the sun for light by day and the fixed order of the moon and the stars for light by night, who stirs up the sea so that its waves roar— the LORD of hosts is his name: ³⁶ "If this fixed order departs from before me, declares the LORD, then shall the offspring of Israel cease from being a nation before me forever." **Jeremiah 31:35-36 (ESV)**

The Eternal Covenant

“Now may the God of peace who brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, the great shepherd of the sheep, **by the blood** of the eternal covenant, ²¹ equip you with everything good that you may do his will, working in us that which is pleasing in his sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory forever and ever. Amen” (Hebrews 13:20-21 (ESV))

“Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. ³⁹ **For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, even as many as the Lord our God shall call.** ⁴⁰ And with many other words did he testify and exhort, saying, Save yourselves from this untoward generation. ⁴¹ Then they that gladly received his word were baptized: and the same day there were added *unto them* about three thousand souls” (Acts 2:38-41 (KJV))
