

## Isaiah 33:17-22 (KJV)

<sup>17</sup> Thine eyes shall see the king in his beauty: they shall behold the land that is very far off.

<sup>18</sup> Thine heart shall meditate terror. Where *is* the scribe? where *is* the receiver? where *is* he that counted the towers? <sup>19</sup> Thou shalt not see a fierce people, a people of a deeper speech than thou canst perceive; of a stammering tongue, *that thou canst* not understand. <sup>20</sup> Look upon Zion, the city of our solemnities: thine eyes shall see Jerusalem a quiet habitation, a tabernacle *that* shall not be taken down; not one of the stakes thereof shall ever be removed, neither shall any of the cords thereof be broken.

<sup>21</sup> But there the glorious LORD *will be* unto us a place of broad rivers *and* streams; wherein shall go no galley with oars, neither shall gallant ship pass thereby. <sup>22</sup> For the LORD *is* our judge, the LORD *is* our lawgiver, the LORD *is* our king; he will save us.

Seven days – to make an end of; God’s completion, to rest from all your toiling (Genesis 7:4)

A day can imply a year or a thousand years (2 Pet. 3:8)

Forty days and Forty Nights – Endurance (*to fulfill, required see Genesis 50:3*) and might to reach the finish line but +there is another leg to go to cross the finish line or to make an end (Genesis 7:4; Genesis 7:17; 8:6)

Jonah message to Nineveh,  
forty days before destruction  
(Jonah 3:4)

Jesus fast forty days (Mat.  
4:2; Luke 4:2)

Jesus with the disciples forty  
days (Acts 1:3)

3. Forty days can imply or become forty years of fulfillment (Num. 14:34; Ezekiel 4:6)

# Doctrine of Grace

Means – Objective (resources) ways of determination of an outcome

Means – God’s Inaugural Dispensation of time, election, fulfillment, commands, statutes

The question may be asked “By What Means”? This, that or another; a devised plan or by any plan; a solemn stand as to say, “by no means”

# Elections & Dispensation



Dispensation is a system of revealed commands of the providence of God regulating human's affairs at an elected time.



Elections are dispensed according to the time of life, which is in Gods timing.
